This **Royal Commission** was about the experience of people with disability.



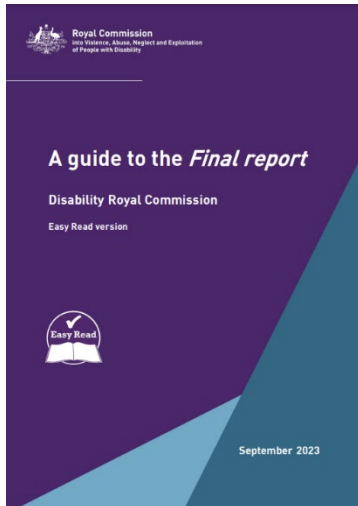
It helps us find out:

- Celebrates people with disability

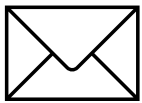


The project team met with other people who are also supporting people with disability in health.
